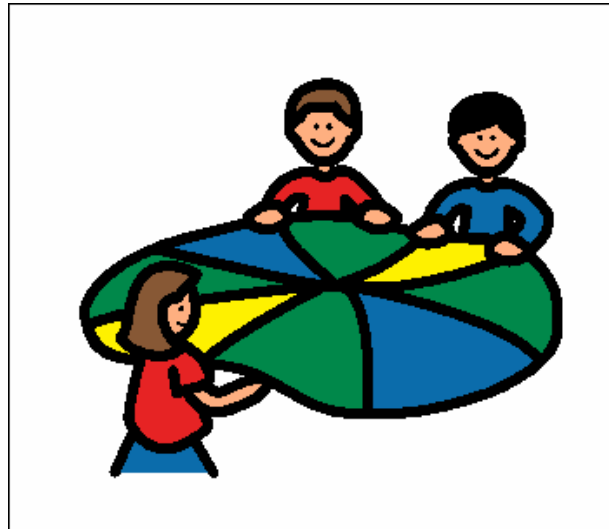
I like to play outside. I can kick a ball with my friends and play on the equipment.



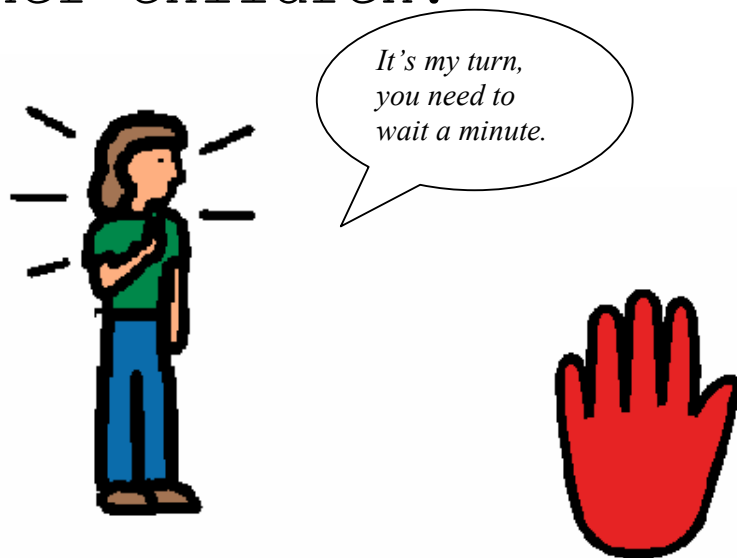
We all share the toys and climbing equipment at preschool.



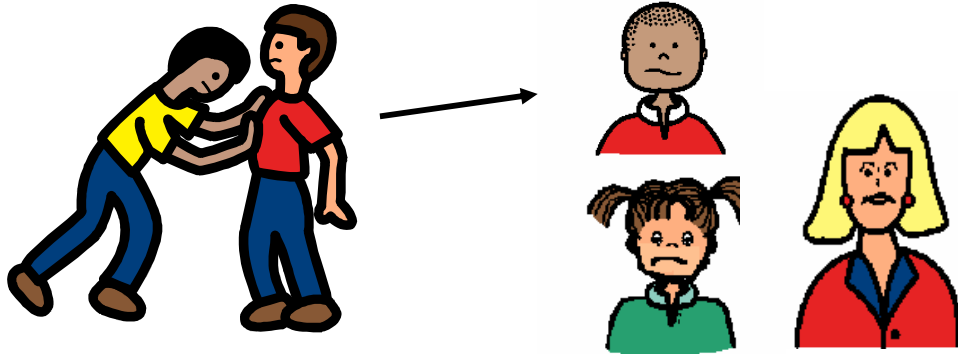
When we share and wait for our turn we all play happily, and help each other.



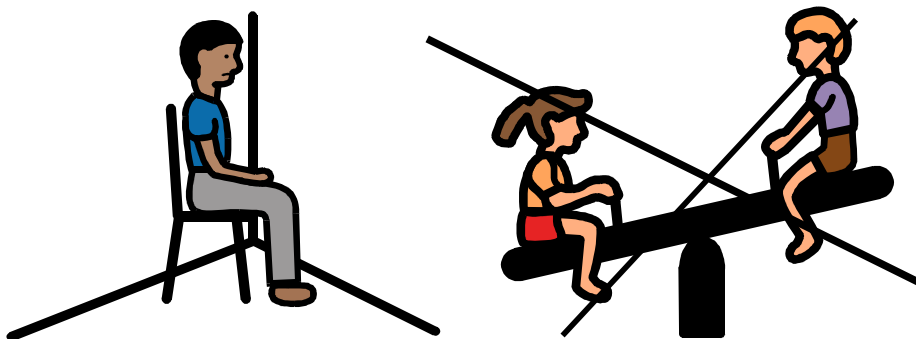
Sometimes, when someone gets excited or wants a turn quickly, they forget that they still need to wait for other children.



Sometimes, when they forget, they push someone, or hit someone. Nobody likes that and the children and the teachers are sad.



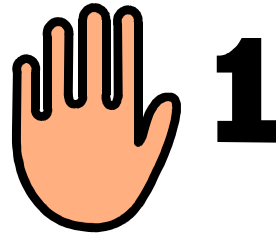
If a child hits or pushes they have to sit on a chair and miss out on play for a while, to help them remember not to do it.

"Could you move for me please?"



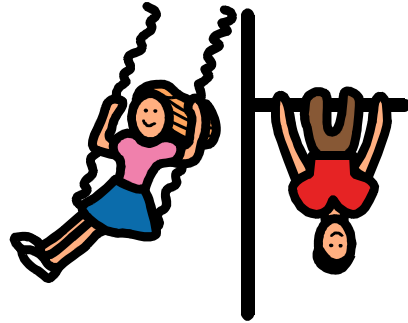
"Can I use that after you?"
